# **Membership & Registration**

**NEW Membership** is valid between April 1st and March 31st of each year and must be renewed annually. Please complete both sides of the enclosed 2022-2023 membership form and return with payment.

Renewal Membership Forms. Last year, we debuted new membership renewal forms which received great feedback from our community! We will be using the new renewal forms again this year, which should make the membership renewal process faster and easier. If you are a returning Hear Québec member, you will receive a simplified renewal membership form in the mail. For the renewal to be successfully processed, the form must still be completed, signed, and returned to Hear Québec with payment.

**Registration:** Please note that registration is mandatory for all programs, events, and services. It is important that you register prior to your activity and not on the day that it starts. Please indicate your interest on the registration form, and return it with your payment. As space may be limited due to COVID protocols, only members who have indicated that they are interested and register for an activity/program will receive updates and information through email. Spots will be reserved on a first-come, first-served basis. Register early to secure your place!

**COVID-19:** With the uncertainty of the restrictions, many of our upcoming programs will be held virtually for the next little while. We hope that things ameliorate in the next few months so that we can begin to return to in-person activities. We will communicate these decisions to you via email, on social media and our website as they are made. Please be assured that if programs are able to return in person, we will do everything in our power to make these events and activities safe and accessible for all involved.
